












#### ABOUT

Long ago in the early Heian Period, the Buddhist monk Kobo Daishi established a monastery in Koyasan, a remote mountain district in in the Kii Mountain Range in present-day Wakayama Prefecture. The mountain became one of the major holy sites of Japanese Buddhism and such is its cultural significance that in 2004 Koyasan was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site, under the category of Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range. The site is visited by large numbers of tourists and pilgrims each year and in Shukubo Temple Lodgings travellers can enjoy the regional specialty of sesame tofu and shojin-ryori made with seasonal ingredients.

\*Shojin-ryori: Vegetarian dishes made without meat or fish according to Buddhist teachings against killing.


















#### **ABOUT**

Japan has a distinguished sake culture similar to the wine cultures of Europe, but unknown to many is its more recent, but much respected, whisky distilling tradition. Japanese whisky came to life at Yamazaki in Osaka Prefecture. In creating a whisky uniquely suited Japanese palates, Shinjiro Torii, Suntory's founder, began construction of Japan's first malt whisky distillery here in 1923. At the Suntory Yamazaki Distillery, visitors can discover the history and techniques of malt whisky distilling and the commitment and artisanship of master distillers.

[Yamazaki Distillery offers two options] Yamazaki Distillery Tour (Paid): learn about the whisky production process and taste Yamazaki whiskies. Yamazaki Whisky Museum Viewing (Free): view various whisky displays and shop and taste whiskies at the tasting counter (paid).

Experience daily life at Ine's Funaya (boat houses by the sea) as a knowledgeable guide takes you around town. A special feature of this tour is the Mondori fishing method, and you may even find Sazae (horned turban shell) and abalone in the sea under the boat house eaves. Pulling out the ropes lying on the sea bottom exposes a big basket swimming with fish. The fish offal is used as bait and put into a basket, which is later thrown into the sea to catch fish again. This is the Mondori system. Japanese sake goes well with Ine's fish. Discover your favorite sake at at the over 260 year old Mukai Shuzo by trying its sake tasting set.
